Network Security is top topic at the BeNeLux Day

First-class speakers provide information at the German-Dutch Security Forum

From September 20 to 23, 2022, the international security industry will be guests at Messe Essen. Security Essen will become a platform for innovative products and knowledge exchange. On September 21, the BeNeLux Day will provide an opportunity to learn from each other. Security Essen, the German-Dutch Chamber of Commerce (DNHK) and the Dutch Cluster Security Delta (HSD) invite to the German-Dutch Security Forum. The following networking meeting will enable participants to intensify contacts.

Criminals do not stop at national borders. Advancing digitalization also increases the risk of becoming a victim of cyberattacks. Dennis Ochmann, Weckbacher Sicherheitssysteme GmbH, Jan Martijn Broekhof, Guardian360, Bastiaan van Hamersveld, Edgeway, and Dominic Schneider, Telenot, will exchange views on stage on the topic of "Networked security technology and cybersecurity in practice.
